



Crystal Palace National Sports Centre, Waterproofing Refurbishment



Project Brief

Opened in 1964, the Crystal Palace National Sports Centre in south London is a large sports centre and athletics track set within 200 acres of parkland. Its Jubilee Stand – built in 1977 to commemorate the Queen’s Silver Jubilee – had started to show signs of failure with ponding water, cracks to the asphalt waterproofing and damaged movement joints.

With the failing section also used as a fire exit, Proteus supplied 800m² of Pro-System to provide a seamless and high quality surface that would ensure safe passage for a high number of people. Proteus also supplied its Pro-Felt system in Black Mineral to repair the vertical movement joints.

Key Requirements: Health and Safety

When working on occupied or public buildings, safety is always of utmost importance. As Pro-System is cold installed, it meets all health and safety criteria to occupied buildings and minimises risk of fire.
